

# Recognition Awards Criteria



## Care of the Late Preterm Infant

Metrics cover entire project timeline (May 2026-June 2027)



**Patient & Family Partner (Goal is 80%-100% achievement in each of the following)**

1. Patient & Family Partner Identified
2. Information sent to Anastacia for TIPQC Onboarding
3. PFP Completes TIPQC Orientation (80%)
4. PFP Completes MoMMA's Voices online training (90%)
5. PFP integrated into hospital QI team (100%)



## **Process Measures # 1-5 (Goal is 90%-100% achievement in each of the following)**

- 1. Percent receiving human milk during hospitalization and/or discharge**
- 2. Percent offered lactation consultation via certificated lactation consultant or nursing/staff member with training**
- 3. Percent discharging with a written feeding plan in discharge paperwork**
- 4. Percent discharging with infection assessment documentation before discharge**
- 5. Percent discharging with hyperbilirubinemia measured and used to guide appropriate discharge and follow-up**



## **Structure Measures (Goal is 90%-100% achievement in each of the following)**

- 1. Percent provider education on LPI discharge**
- 2. Percent nursing education on LPI discharge**
- 3. Standardized LPI-specific discharge ready policy and procedure implemented**
- 4. LPI-specific written feeding plans at discharge**
- 5. Patient/family partner (Goal is 80%-100%)**



## Outcome Measures #1 (Goal is 90-100% achievement)

1. Percent of infants discharged with a "Discharge Ready" Checklist Completion\*  
*(Optional: Readmission of LPI)*

*\*Disaggregated by race, ethnicity and payor*
