- Submit your monthly leadership report with updated IHI scores, PDSA Cycles, etc
- Submit monthly data, if applicable

Quarterly Expectations

- Schedule quarterly coaching calls with TIPQC
- Review project data monthly and quarterly to look for trends or changes based on PDSA Cycles
- Submit quarterly data on Process & Structure Measures
